This handbook sets out information about the Nippers program at Kingston Beach SLSC. It is intended to help both prospective new members and returning members alike.

Kingston Beach Surf Lifesaving Club is a young but growing club. Our Nippers program continues to grow year on year, and we now have over 160 registered KBSLSC Nippers which is fantastic!

Like most Surf Lifesaving Clubs, Kingston Beach SLSC is very family orientated and the focus is primarily to ensure that our Nipper program is both fun, challenging, and educational, not only for the children but also for the parents and guardians who join us on the beach. We have opportunities for those Nippers who are wanting to learn beach awareness and become our future patrolling team members, but we also cater to those competitive Nippers with a passion for surf sports. There is something for everyone at KBSLSC.

We hope you find this handbook useful and look forward to welcoming you and your child/ren to our club!

#### **PARENTS RUN NIPPERS!**

**Our Club operates entirely on volunteer help.** There are many jobs, and for most of these, Surf Life Saving experience is not required.

Our experience is that *the more you get involved, the more your child will enjoy Nippers*. Roles that parents can help with include:

- Equipment set-up and pack-up
- Age Managers
- Assistant Age Managers
- Water Safety
- Fundraising
- BBQ Roster
- Carnival Judge/Official
- Timekeeper for rotations



Your assistance on the beach will be regularly required and we count on volunteers to keep the sessions running smoothly. Age Managers are a crucial part of our Nippers program, and we require parents to fill these roles for the age groups. Please let us know if you would like to be an Age Manager, or assistant Age Manager, or want to be mentored by a current Age Manager. We have simple training options available and WOULD LOVE your help on the beach in these roles! Please talk to our Junior Activities Team if you are interested.

# SUNDAY ACTIVITIES

Our main Nippers session traditionally runs on a Sunday morning in the middle of Kingston Beach. We begin the morning by assembling at the club facility (situated

behind the public ablutions) at 9:45am. Our Nippers need to assemble with their Age Manager and be signed off before the session commences. Nippers should be organised and ready to go with their nipper cap, pink vest on, have sunscreen applied and water bottles, goggles, wetsuit and towel ready to go.

It is important to note that each child must be marked off the roll prior to leaving with parent at the end of the session.

### **SESSION TIMES**

Nippers runs for two hours on a Sunday morning and Seahorses run for one hour Arrival time 9:45 for a 10am start

Nippers (U8-U14): 10.00 am – 12:00pm Seahorses: 10.00 am -11.00am

\* Sessions may be cancelled or cut short some weeks due to weather. If this happens (which is rare), you will receive a text message as well as Facebook and TeamApp notification by 8:30am Sunday morning.

PLEASE NOTE: A PARENT OR GUARDIAN IS REQUIRED TO BE ON THE BEACH AT ALL TIMES, DURING NIPPERS. YOUR CHILD IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY, NIPPERS DOES NOT RUN LIKE A CHILD-MINDING PROGRAM.

TRIPS TO THE TOILET, SUN PROTECTION AND THE GENERAL WELFARE OF EACH CHILD ON KINGSTON BEACH IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THEIR PARENT OR GUARDIAN.

# NIPPER SEASON START

The 2021/22 beach season commences on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> November with our club Open Day. Our Open Day does not run like a normal Nippers session. It is a day for the community to come down and see how our club runs and for interested kids to give nippers a try.

Three pool proficiency sessions will be run prior to our open day. More information on these days will be advertised internally closer to the time.











#### SURF EDUCATION

The SurfEd program is what Nippers is all about and is based on a clearly defined structure and outcomes to aid the children's lifesaving development. During the season, all Nippers can gain their respective SurfEd award for their age group.

These certificates are only issued to children participating in their correct age group who have met the minimum requirements regarding attendance and participation. SurfEd awards are tracked against your child's name in the national database system and is a great pathway for them to gain their SRC and Bronze Medallion.

All SurfEd awards are issued to the nippers at our annual nipper break up function at the end of the season.

#### SURF SPORTS

As well as the SurfEd program, our Sunday sessions are made up of water skills which familiarise children with being in the sea including wades, swims, board skills, swim / board relays and a host of other aquatic based skills training.

After their water and education rotation they will move to a dedicated beach area where new skills such as flags training, beach sprints, sprint relays, 1km beach runs etc will be conducted. Our Sunday Surf & Beach Skill Sessions are action packed on land and in the water to ensure your nipper has the best time!

#### COMMUNICATION

Our club uses several forms of communication to keep in touch. Our combination of email, Facebook and TeamApp should keep you covered. To stay on top of club news and information please keep an eye on all these helpful sources.

#### **ADDITIONAL TRAINING**

Kingston Beach SLSC may choose to offer additional training for interested members in the following areas:

**U10-U14 Board Training** Thursday 4:15 – 5:30pm (see our Facebook Members page for updates)

**CADET TRAINING (U14 – Open):** Thursday evening and Sunday Mornings. Our cadets have a Messenger group which is used for updates. Please ask coach Maddy McBride to be added to this group.

**Clifton Beach Training :** Friday Evenings 5 onwards. Occasionally we are invited to the Friday night Clifton SLSC board training in order to get some wave action, but these are not regular sessions and will be advertised via our various communications platforms.

#### **UNIFORM & GEAR SALES**

For safety reasons ALL children MUST wear a cap during all activities on the beach. Our seahorses wear a plain aqua blue cap and all other nippers wear our blue/yellow club cap. ALL participants in aquatic activities must also wear a high visibility pink vest. This is a national safety requirement.

Club apparel and caps, vests, etc. are on sale most Sunday mornings at the beach. We have a great range of kids and adult swimwear, and polo shirts, hoodies, caps etc. They all make great gifts and are great to represent the club at Carnivals!





### AGE GROUP CALCULATION

When your child joins nippers, they will be placed in an age group category. Often a source of confusion, we've tried to make this as easy as possible for our members! The age group for your child is calculated from the age they are, on or prior to, 30<sup>th</sup> September.

For example, if your child is 11 on the 30<sup>th</sup> September of this year, they will be in the Under 12 age group for the season.

If your child has friends in neighbouring age groups we can be flexible in allowing them to train on Sunday with their friends, however, due to the age groups being set by Surf Life Saving Australia, the age groups are fixed for competition and children cannot move into different age group categories at carnivals unless they are competing up an age group to assist with numbers.

#### PARENT BRONZE MEDALLION OR SRC TRAINING

At the beginning and during the season training is arranged for any parent (who is an active member) interested in obtaining their Surf Rescue Certificate or Bronze Medallion. The Bronze Medallion course can be one of the most rewarding courses you can attempt.

Once qualified you can join our Water Safety Team or even one of our beach patrol teams. Courses are normally run over four-five weeks and we are very flexible in working around parent schedules. For more information on these awards, get in touch with Bridget (Training officer) on the beach.





### **CHILD PROTECTION**

Kingston Beach SLSC is committed to the Safeguarding of Children and Young People, under the age of 18, and acknowledges that a child-safe organisation doesn't just happen; it requires conscious action to protect children from harm.

Any parent assisting on the beach must be registered as an associate member or Nipper Parent Member this season for safety reasons. All lifesavers and parent helpers also need to apply and show proof of approval of a *"Working with Vulnerable People"* card for child protection. Please complete the registration process at:

https://www.cbos.tas.gov.au/topics/licensing-and-registration/registrations/work-with-vulnerablepeople and once you receive your approval email (from 1 week, but up to 4 weeks), please email your approval WWVP number and details to our club email. If you already have a card, please show our Nippers team on the beach on a Sunday so the club can record the details.

### EQUIPMENT USE

On Sundays and during mid-week training sessions nippers are provided with lots of equipment to use to supplement their training and skill development. Surf lifesaving gear is very expensive to purchase and repair, so we ask you to please remind your children to take care with all our gear! The steps on the beach and the retaining wall near the storage shed are HOT SPOTS for damage to our boards, so please look out for this when children are transporting gear to and from the beach.

For carnivals, club boards are transported with the club's gear trailer. On occasion, when the gear trailer is not required, equipment may be signed out to members for transportation to carnivals and off-site training sessions. This must be approved by the Junior Activities Coordinator prior to signing out any equipment and a condition report completed before signing out and upon return.

#### **SUN PROTECTION**

Our club is very aware of the importance of proper sun protection and encourages all surf lifesavers, nippers, guardians, and visitors to the beach to be sun smart.

Please make sure your child has their sunscreen applied before they join their age group on Sunday morning. Please note: Age Managers are neither responsible nor allowed (child protection laws) to apply sunscreen to the children, this is your job as a parent.

#### NIPPER BBQS

To help fundraise, we hold regular Sausage Sizzles after Nippers on a Sunday morning at our new shed across the road from the beach, adjacent to the new toilet facilities – please support the club, come over, check out our facilities and buy a snag or two when you can. This is a weekly occurrence, and we rely on the age group on duty to run this initiative. All funds raised go towards new nipper equipment including boards, balls, flags etc.












# REGISTRATION

Surf Life Saving Australia (SLSA) requires all nippers to be current financial members of a club. Non-financial members will therefore not be able to participate until their membership is renewed and paid online. New members need to create an individual account with SLSA. For families joining, create an account for each family member. We also have a <u>parent policy</u> in place which requires at least one parent to join when they join a nipper/s up to our club.

Select that you have not been a member of a Surf Club before – select that you want to join a Surf Life Saving Club – select Kingston Beach SLSC – select join a family. (It is important to select Family as we have a Nipper Parent policy which requires at least one parent/guardian to become a member alongside their child/children).

Your request will then go to the club to be accepted by the club registrar. If you have any problems with the registration process, please email the club account <u>kingstonbeachslsc@gmail.com</u> and we will give you a hand.

#### **SWIM PROFICIENCIES**

Water proficiencies are a very important part of the Kingston Beach Surf Life Saving



Club's initial assessments for safety and competence. We are NOT a learn-to-swim school. All children wishing to enter the water during nipper activities MUST have a basic level of competency in a pool. Furthermore, anyone wishing to compete in water events or attend board and swim training must successfully complete the <u>competition evaluation</u> at the beach.

All nippers are required to participate in this evaluation (conducted by Kingston Beach SLSC) prior to any water activity at the beach on a Sunday, mid-week training or carnival participation.

### CARNIVALS

U8 – U14 age groups can compete and are required to have both their pool and open water swimming proficiency complete in order to be eligible for competition.
